INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place the bag in the rack and center it.
2. FOR 2-UP BAG ONLY-Attach the two side pockets by placing the pocket over the rack bar and connecting the velcro straps.
3. Thread the side release buckles onto the 1-1/2" webbings. Thread the rear webbings around the rack bars & connect the buckles. Thread the front buckle straps around the backrest and connect the buckles.
4. Tighten the webbing making sure that it is snug and that the bag is still centered.
(You may tighten webbing to a maximum of 180 lbs.)

CAUTION: Do not carry heavy, sharp, or pointed objects in the rack bag.
Evenly distribute the weight. Maximum carrying capacity of the bag is 10 lbs.
Make sure the load does not shift during riding.
It is recommended that after each ride or periodically check and when necessary clean the zippered portion of the rack bag with clean water. Dirt and residue build up can cause zipper failure.

WARNING! Do not store in direct sunlight, direct extensive exposure will cause the material to fade prematurely! It is recommended that you cover your unit when not in use.
