

EDGE TOURING SIDE RACK BAG #2874670

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place the bag in the rack front first and center it.
- 2. Thread the side release buckles onto the webbings. Thread the front webbings around the bottom inside corner of the bag connecting the buckles.
- 3. Tighten the webbing making sure that it is snug and that the bag is still centered.
- 4. Feed the rear straps around the vertical bar and connecting the buckles. Cinch all straps tight

CAUTION: Do not carry heavy, sharp, or pointed objects in the rack bag.

Evenly distribute the weight. Maximum carrying capacity of the bag is 3 lbs. per bag. Make sure the load does not shift during riding.

It is recommended that after each ride or periodically check and when necessary clean the zippered portion of the rack bag with clean water. Dirt and residue build up can cause zipper failure.

WARNING! Do not store in direct sunlight, direct extensive exposure will cause the material to fade prematurely! It is recommended that you cover your unit when not in use.
