

Installation Instructions ATV RACK BAG/ BIG REAR Part No. ABA-4SH51-30-00


Please read and understand the instructions completely before installation to avoid any possible injury to yourself or damage to the accessory or your ATV.

DEALER: These instructions contain important information for future reference and must be given to the customer.

1. PARTS LIST:

Study the illustration thoroughly before proceeding.



2. INSTALLATION:

- a) Thread the male SR-1 buckles on to the attachment straps. (See A)
- b) Place the bag on the rear rack so that the female quick release buckles are facing toward the rear.
- c) Thread the two center straps under the rack, connect the quick release buckles and cinch tight. Center the bag on the rack and secure the end buckles.
- d) Check that the bag is centered and square before loading.

Note: Do not store the ATV outdoors with the rack bag installed. Direct, long term exposure to sunlight will result in fading and or tendering of the material. It is recommended that the rack bag be removed from the ATV when it is not in use. Damage resulting from exposure to direct sunlight cannot be warranteed.

3. LOADING CONSIDERATIONS:

- a) NEVER OVERLOAD the rear rack bag.
- b) DO NOT carry sharp, pointed or heavy objects, and distribute the load evenly.

4. CARE & CLEANING:

Use a "Vacuum cleaner", sponge or cloth and clean water. Do not use detergents or harsh chemicals.

5. CUSTOMER SERVICE: See your YAMAHA dealer.
