

Installation Instructions ATV RACK BAG/ FRONT Part No. ABB-4SH53-30-00

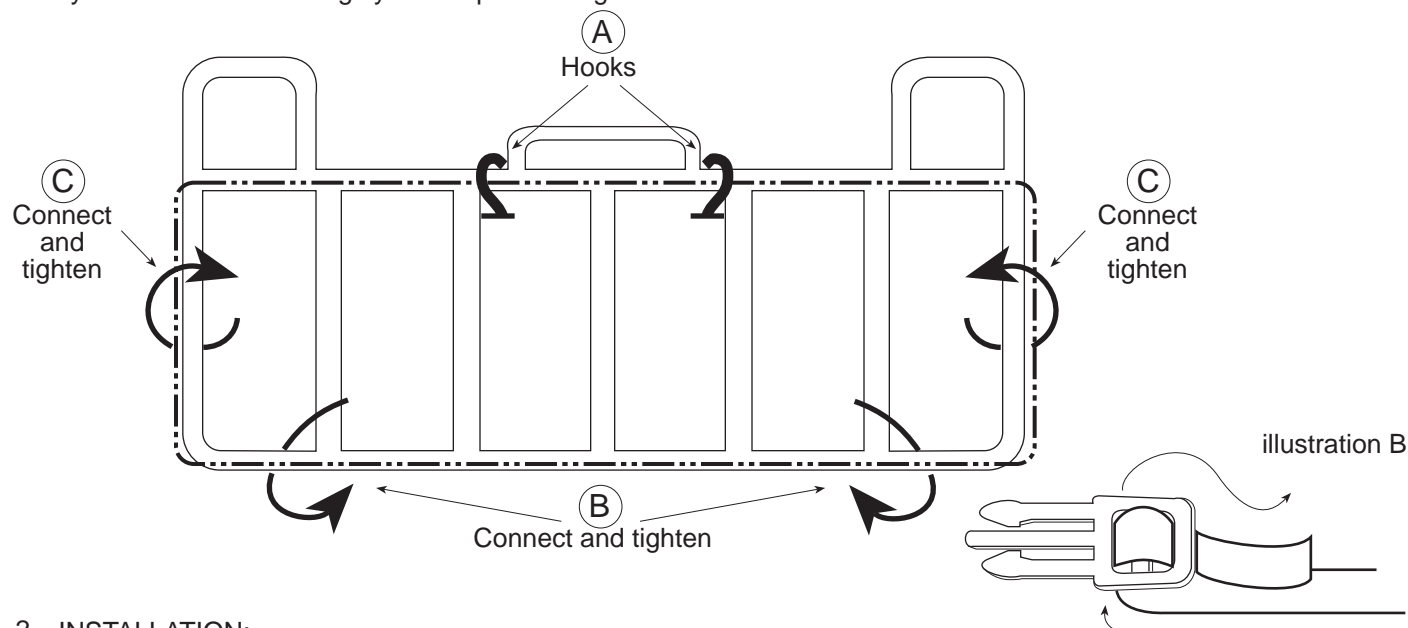
Please read and understand the instructions completely before installation to avoid any possible injury to yourself or damage to the accessory or your ATV.

DEALER: These instructions contain important information for future reference and must be given to the customer.

1. PARTS LIST:

Study the illustration thoroughly before proceeding.



2. INSTALLATION:

- Place the rack bag on the front rack so that the two hooks grip the rear most tube on either side of the cargo loop. (See A)
- Attach the SR-3/4" buckles to the corresponding attachment straps. (See B)
- Thread the webbing straps through the rack as per diagram and cinch tight. (See C)
Note: If the bag is installed on a smaller rack such as on the Wolverine, it is recommended that the excess webbing be trimmed. To do so, simply install the bag and tighten all straps, measure 4" from where the webbing enters the buckle (to allow for adjustment), cut the webbing and burn the end with a cigarette lighter to prevent fraying.
- Thread SR-1" buckle from sub-assembly to 1" webbing straps, as seen in illustration B. These straps are provided to cinch and secure load. Cinch and secure over the top of the bag.

Caution: Do not store the ATV outdoors with the rack bag installed. Direct, long term exposure to sunlight will result in fading and or tendering of the material. It is recommended that the rack bag be removed from the ATV when it is not in use. Damage resulting from exposure to direct sunlight cannot be warranted.

3. LOADING CONSIDERATIONS:

- NEVER OVERLOAD the front rack bag. Weight limitation is 10 lbs.
- DO NOT carry sharp, pointed or heavy objects, and distribute the load evenly.

4. CARE & CLEANING:

Use a "Vacuum cleaner", sponge or cloth and clean water. Do not use detergents or harsh chemicals.
