## 1. PARTS LIST:

## 2. INSTALLATION:

### Seat:

1. Remove the seat from the vehicle.
2. Drape the cover over the seat, with the "H" seam at the top of the seat.
3. Thread the loop Velcro through the drain holes in the seat well.
4. Fit the cover around the edges of the seat and secure the Velcro. The seat cover should be pulled taught prior to attaching velcro for best fit readjust as necessary.

### Headrest cover:

1. Remove any accessory blocking view of the back of the headrest cover.
2. Slip the headrest cover over the top of the headrest. Adjust for best fit. Ensure that the self adhesive Velcro supplied is evenly applied to the Velcro tab at the bottom of the headrest cover, adhesive face up.
3. Apply tension to the lower Velcro so that the cover is tight. While still applying tension, peel the backing from the self adhesive Velcro and apply to the back of the headrest.
4. Secure the two side Velcro straps for a tight fit.

## 3. CARE & CLEANING:

Do not store camo in direct sunlight use a cover or store in shaded area. Storing in direct sunlight may result in fading of the material. Damage due to fading is not covered under the warranty. Do not machine wash or dry, do not use harsh detergents. To clean, rinse in cold water and allow to air dry.
