INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE:

- Please read and understand these instructions completely before installation to avoid any possible injury to yourself or damage to the accessory.
- DEALER: These instructions contain important information for future reference and must be given to the consumer.
- Make sure you have gathered all necessary parts and tolls before you begin.

1) FRAME INSTALLATION

- At the rear of the bimini, zip the end of the bimini extension to the bimini.
- Matching up the color on the side poles with the color on the middle pole, connect middle pole to the side poles and insert into the sewn sleeve of the bimini extension.

2) ACCON INSTALLATION

- Using the template provided, mark the location of the screw holes for the accon mount as shown in Fig. 1.
- After marking the holes, cover the area to be drilled with masking tape. Your markings
 will still be visible through the tape, and doing this will prevent the drill bit from chipping
 the gelcoat.
- Pre-drill holes with a 1/8" drill bit, then using a #2 Phillips screwdriver mount the accon with the screws provided.

Repeat this procedure on the other side of the boat. The mounting measurements and instructions are identical.

3) SNAP LOOP INSTALLATION

- Mark the location of the snap loop as shown in Fig. 2.
- Tape and pre-drill 1/8" holes, then using a #2 Phillips screwdriver mount the snap loop with the screws provided.

Repeat this procedure on the other side of the boat. The mounting measurements and instructions are identical.

4) BIMINI EXTENSION INSTALLATION

- Connect the quick release end of the side pole to the accon mount.
- Locate the straps on the bimini extension and adjust them so they will be taught when they are connected into the snap loops.
- Connect straps from bimini extension to snap loops.






